RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education accepts the resignation of Ms. Yamira Alfano, Office Assistant-Financial Support for District Office, effective June 8, 2007.

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education accepts the resignation, for the purpose of retirement, of Ms. Maryann Castellano, teacher aide at Pequenakonck Elementary School, effective June 30, 2007.

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education hereby amends its Table of Organization for 2007-08 to include two additional teachers of mathematics, one additional high school special education teacher, and one additional district wide special education teacher (funded by a grant).

RESOLVED, that upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the appointment of Mr. Douglas Coates as a probationary teacher effective from September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2010, in the K-12 music tenure area. Mr. Coates possesses initial certification as a music teacher, which permits him to teach in the state of New York. Mr. Coates' placement on the schedule is BA-5A, at an annual salary of \$57,171.

Ms. Danielle LaJoie

RESOLVED, that upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the appointment of Ms. Danielle LaJoie as a probationary teacher effective from September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2009, in the 7-12 foreign languages tenure area. Ms. LaJoie possesses permanent certifications as a 7-12 French teacher, 7-12 Spanish teacher and nursery K-6 teacher, which permits her to teach in the state of New York. Ms. LaJoie's placement on the schedule is MA-8D, at an annual salary of \$74,450.

Ms. Kylie McCarron

RESOLVED, that upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the appointment of Ms. Kylie McCarron as a probationary teacher effective from September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2010, in the 7-12 English academic tenure area. Ms. McCarron possesses initial certification as a 7-12 English Language Arts teacher which permits her to teach in the state of New York. Ms. McCarran's placement on the schedule is BA-2A, at an annual salary of \$50,098.00.

Ms. Elizabeth Roman

RESOLVED, that upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the probationary appointment of Ms. Elizabeth Roman as a K-12 teacher assistant assigned to PQ for 2007-2008, effective from September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2010. Zeien's placement on the schedule is MA-6D, at an annual salary of \$68,176.

Ms. Patrice Milillo

Ms. Milillo's placement on the schedule is MA-3D, at an annual salary of \$59,742. (Ms. Milillo will assume the special education teaching position held by Ms. Kristal Castellano in 2006-07. Ms. Castellano will be assigned to the newly established district wide special education position.)
